Construction Update

We're excited to report that sitework is underway at Washington Place. Erland Construction has stripped the remaining asphalt and started excavating the perimeter of the site in preparation for SOE installation. This is the temporary pile and lagging structure that will be set in place around the future building footprint to accommodate mass excavation for our underground parking garage.

New concrete jersey barriers have been setup along Washington St. and Walnut St. to provide safe paths for pedestrian travel around the site. These protected access ways are lined with banners that display the creations of Newton based artists Chuck Holtzman and Adrienne Shishko. The murals are part of Fence Art Gallery at Washington Place, an effort sponsored by Mark Development to use local art and creativity to enhance our streetscape.

We hope you take the time to read about these pieces next time you pass through the neighborhood.
